CONFIRMATION

Confirmation date: Sunday, May 26 at 10.30 a.m. by a bishop.
Fr. Hubka already started the preparation for this sacrament. The sessions will be in the conference room after Mass each Sunday except the first Sunday of a month (Scouting Sunday) and Easter Sunday.

TOGETHER IN ACTION (TIA)

Traditionally, this is part our Lenten observance in the Diocese of Calgary – the almsgiving part of the three legs of the Lenten stool – prayers, fasting, and almsgiving, that is giving to those in need.

Each leg of the stool supports and supported by the other two.
For example, if we give up steak and lobster during Lent, we have more money to give to TIA. There was once the idea (or the ideal) that we, through our Lenten sacrifices, would reach the parish goal by Easter.

GOOD FRIDAY, like Ash Wednesday, is a day of fast and abstinence (no meat).

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION, March 29

In this diocese half of this collection goes to assist the Church in the Holy Land, supporting its pastoral, educational, and social works, and helping to maintain the Holy Places so important for the faith of Christians everywhere.

The other half goes to the Diocese Mission Council to support various missions elsewhere in the world.
