WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS – next Sunday, April 26

Catholics are invited to reflect on the meaning of God's call and to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, Christ, the Lord Shepherd (cf. the gospel for that day), continues to lead his people through his bishops, priests, and deacons, and through those called to religious life. Please pray for vocations and not on one day only.

MARRIAGE IN THE LORD (from Catechism of the Catholic Church)

1614 “In his preaching Jesus unequivocally taught the original meaning of the union of man and woman as the Creator willed it from the beginning...

1615 “This unequivocal insistence on the indissolubility of the marriage bond may have left some perplexed and could seem to be a demand impossible to realize... This grace of Christian marriage is a fruit of Christ's cross, the source of all Christian life.

1623 “In the Latin Church, it is ordinarily understood that the spouses, as ministers of Christ's grace, mutually confer upon each other the sacrament of Matrimony by expressing this consent before the Church...

1625 “The parties to a marriage covenant are a baptized man and woman, free to contract marriage, who freely express their consent; ‘to be free’ means:

- not being under constraint
- not impeded by any natural or ecclesiastical law.

1626 “The Church holds the exchange of consent between the spouses to be the indispensable element that ‘makes the marriage’. If consent is lacking, there is no marriage.

Note: Depending on available space in the bulletin, there will be, from time to time, further explanations of a very complex subject.

ST. MARK – Saturday, April 25

He was probably the young man who ran away when Jesus was arrested (Mark 14: 51-52). He accompanied Paul and Barnabas (Mark's cousin) on Paul's first missionary journey. Afterwards he followed Peter to Rome; Peter calls him “my son Mark” (1Peter 5:13). According to a tradition, he became the first bishop of Alexandria in Egypt. In the 9th century his relics were brought from there to Venice in Italy, of which he became the patron saint. His main emblem is a winged lion. The shortest gospel has always been attributed to him.
