COUNTING WEEKEND – August 15, 16

Several times a year the Diocese asks every parish to count those attending Mass. It would be nice to have people in good number as Masses on August 15 & 16 the next Counting Weekend.

ST. LAWRENCE – Monday, August 10

He was one of the seven deacons in Rome and was put to death in 258. Deacons looked after caring the poor. The story is that when asked to give up the treasures of the church, he assembled the widows and orphans and said that these were the church's treasures.

ST CLARE – Thursday - August 11

She was born in 1194 and died in 1253. A follower of St. Francis of Assisi, she founded the Poor Clares, a strict order of women religious, which still exists.

ST. MAXIMILIAN KOLBE – Friday, August 14

He was born in Poland in 1894 and became a Franciscan priest, serving in Japan. Called back to Europe, he was arrested by the Gestapo and taken to Auschwitz where he gave his life so that a man with a wife and children might live – in 1941.

ASSUMPTION of the BLESSED VIRGIN MARY – Saturday, August 15

Our Lady, having completed her life on earth, was taken up, body and soul, to heaven.
