ST. CHARLES LWANGA & COMPANIONS – Wednesday, June 3

Charles was baptized in November of 1885 and was burnt alive on June 3, 1886. He and twenty-one other boys and young men, aged 14 to 30, opposed the evil practices of Mwanga, king of Buganda, now part Uganda in Africa, and were put to death.

ST. BONIFACE – Friday, June 5

He was born about 675 of Anglo-Saxon family in southern England and was given the name Winfrith (or Wynfrid).

When he was five he was entered into a Benedictine monastery in Exeter where he was educated and eventually became a monk, and was ordained a priest in 710. In 716 he set out on a missionary journey to Germany (the Anglo-Saxons had come from Germany and so their language was still much the same as those who lived there).

In 718 he went to Rome where Pope Gregory II gave him a definite mission to preach the Gospel in central Germany (Bavaria and Hesse). He brought monks from England to help. In 732 Pope Gregory III made him an archbishop with the power to consecrate other bishops. When he was about eighty, he returned to northern Germany where he was put to death by pagans in 754. Somewhere along the line, he had the name Boniface, Bonifacio in Latin, meaning doer of good (bonum facere).
