WORD CONFERENCE 2026

The Diocese will hold this on Friday, October 2, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at St. Mary's Cathedral, and Saturday, October 3, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at St. Mary's High School. Archbishop Paul-André Durocher will be the main speaker. The conference focuses on lifelong discipleship and formation across the stages of life.

THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS – Monday, September 14

This commemorates the recovery by the Byzantine emperor Heraclius of the Cross which in 614 had been taken from Jerusalem by the Persians, who at that time were still Zoroastrians (not Muslims). This actually happened on March 21, 629, but the September 14 date also remembered the date of the dedication in 335 of the dedication of the basilica built on the order of the Emperor Constantine.

OUR LADY OF SORROWS – Tuesday, September 15

This naturally follows on the previous day. It is a much more recent observance, extended to the whole Church in 1814 by Pope Pius VII in commemoration of the sufferings he had suffered under Napoleon.

STS. CORNELIUS and CYPRIAN – Wednesday, September 16

The 250's were a difficult decade for the Church. There were persecution under which both Pope Cornelius and Cyprian, bishop of Carthage, a great city in north Africa, suffered as martyrs. There were also great tensions within the Church about how to treat members who had denied the faith under persecution and who later wanted to return to the Church, Both Cornelius and Cyprian favoured leniency.

THE HOLY CHILDHOOD, the Pope's own missionary work for children. October is Mission Month. World Mission Sunday is October 18.
