Archbishop Paul-André Durocher will be the main speaker. The conference focuses on lifelong discipleship and formation across the stages of life.

ST. PIUS of PIETRELCINA (PADRE PIO) – Wednesday, September 23

He was born in Italy in 1887 and died in 1968. He was ordained a priest as a Capuchin (a branch of the Franciscans) in 1910 and heard confessions from dawn to dusk.

THE CANADIAN MARTYRS – Saturday, September 26

Six Jesuits priests and two laymen, all from France, who were put to death by the Iroquois between 1642 and 1649. Saints Jean de Brébeuf, Isaac Jogues, Antoine Daniel, Gabriel Lalemant, Charles Garnier, Noël Chabanel, and Jean de la Lande, pray for Canada.
